## BOWLING

COMPETITION DIVISIONS: Bowling is an age category competition based on the following forms of play:

Singles -Divided into both men and women divisions.
Doubles - Can be mixed gender.
Teams (consists of four people) - can be mixed gender.

## TOURNAMENT:

All events for singles, doubles, and teams will be handicap.

## FORMAT:

Each event will consist of three games.
SCORING:

1. The total pins bowled with handicap will be the bowler's total score.
2. Handicaps for both men and women will be figured at $85 \%$ of 200 based on the bowlers last year book average. If a bowler doesn't have a book average, it will be 135 for women and 155 for men.
3. Winners will be awarded and receive in each age category below the gold, silver, and bronze medals.
