DISCUS

COMPETITION DIVISIONS: Discus is an individual age competition which is divided into both men and women divisions.

TOURNAMENT:

Each contestant will be allowed three throws. Competition is based on distance.

FORMAT:

- 1. The field will be a marked sector with a seven foot diameter circle or toe board.
- 2. Throws must be made from within the painted circle or toe board.

SCORING:

- 1. The distance of each throw will be measured to the nearest 1/4 inch from the front end of the painted circle or toe board to where the discus lands.
- 2. If during a throw a contestant steps on or over the painted circle, the throw will be declared a foul and shall not be measured, It will count as one of the competitor's three throws.
- 3. In the event of a tie, the higher place shall be awarded to the contestant whose second best throw is better than the second best throw of any other competitor tied for that place.
- 4. Competitors with the greatest scoring distance in each age category below will receive the gold, silver, and bronze medals.

EQUIPMENT:

The use of any discus other than those furnished by the Golden Games Committee will not be allowed. The Discus weights to be used are as follows:

Men: 50 - 59 1.6K Women: All age groups 1.0K 60+ 1.0K
